

GAME 6 – San Joaquin Delta 11, Orange Coast 10, 11 innings

FRESNO – Cody Scott's two-out, game-winning single in the bottom of the 11<sup>th</sup> inning lifted the San Joaquin Delta College Mustangs to an 11-10, 11-inning win over Orange Coast College on Monday at the 2009 CCCAA State Baseball Championships, played at Fresno City College's John Eules Ballpark.

With the win, the Mustangs avoided elimination and forced a must-win game for both teams, which will start at 4:30 p.m.

Stuart Burnett had two hits, including a three-run home run and finished with four RBI for the Mustangs (34-18). Vinnie Devencenzi and Brett Morgan each had three hits and combined for four runs and two RBI.

Chris Anklam threw 4 1/3 innings of scoreless relief to pick up the win and improve to 5-1. OCC's Brett Williams took the hard-luck loss and fell to 4-3 after 3 1/3 innings of relief.

Ryan Dunn went 2-for-3 with three runs and two RBI, while Ricky and Mykal Stokes combined for three this and five RBI for the Pirates (36-14).

The game featured four lead changes. In the seventh, Mykal Stokes' two-run double drove in Ryan Sheeks and Dunn to give OCC a 10-8 lead.

But the Mustangs came back in the bottom of the frame when Devencenzi ripped a two-run single to left, scoring Morgan and Aaron Rowley to tie the game at 10.
